1. This is further to the Directorate of Administration's (DA's) response dated 6 September 2000 (below) regarding Roger Hall's F-1998-00735 request as outlined in our 6 September lotus note. Subsequent to our 6 September response, the [Redacted] called to say that she had read in a DA report about the recent inquiry from the SSCI regarding US military personnel listed as prisoner, missing or unaccounted for since 1965 and wanted us to know that she had some files that may contain relevant information.

2. Based upon our subsequent phone conversation with the [Redacted] we determined that it was necessary to review the files to determine as to whether any information contained therein was relevant to any of the three FOIA requests submitted by Mr. Hall. Upon our review, we identified three documents that somewhat pertain to Mr. Hall's F-1998-00735 request, [Redacted]
